### 1. Notice of Liability

- Fill in the blanks (all copy in red is for you to complete) on this template and display on your window or door to prevent bylaw/police from entering

### 2. Notice of Trespass + liability

- Fill in the blanks (all copy in red is for you to complete) on this template with the names of the any bylaw/police officer(s) who attempt to trespass on your business/property

### 3. Script for authorities

- Keep this handy. Should you be confronted by an officer, use this to enact common law and remove yourself from the illegal framework that has been set up without your consent.
- Sit in your knowing and be confident, YOU HOLD ALL THE POWER

i...require evidence to jurisdiction upon which <each name of bylaw/officer> rely produced

## Script for Trespass

**\*\*\*Always get the name and badge # of any officer you speak with. Get a business card if possible or write down their information.\*\*\***

1. Understand is a legalese term, as a living breathing man/woman of the land we DO NOT UNDERSTAND, as that is to STAND UNDER SOMEONE.

If asked "if you understand", make the claim by stating that you DO NOT STAND UNDER THEM, you comprehend.

**State: "I do not stand under you, I do comprehend what you are saying"**

2. Ask them who they are representing, which will be the service corporation of Milton. Let them know they are out of their jurisdiction as Heather is NOT in contract with the service corporation of Milton.

**Ask: "who are you here representing today?" and the answer would be the town/city of Milton to which the response is "I am outside of your jurisdiction of the service corporation of Milton"**

3. Ask them to show you/Heather where the law applies to a living/breathing man/woman of the land.

**Ask: "show me where in the law does it states it applies to a living breathing woman of the land?"**

- The law applies to a person, a "person" under the law is an entity and is NOT LIVING.
- The law does NOT apply to a living/breathing man/woman of the land so they will NOT be able to find that in the law.
- The bylaw and police officers know this as well.
